Web Content

Include PC(USA) RSS feeds to keep your Web content fresh and up-to-date! RSS or Really Simple Syndication is a way for the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) to continuously "feed" your Web site announcements about the latest updates to pcusa.org. The information on your Web page will include the title of the feed, a brief description and a link to the full story.

It really is simple to add these dynamic features to your website. First, set up an account, then build your feed by choosing one of the five feeds (described below), then define the size you want to dedicate to the feed—don't worry if you get it wrong, you can easily change it later. You may also select the color of the text and border so it will aesthetically fit in with your web site.
